

## ••• WATERCOLOR MATERIALS •••

Bring supplies you have or prefer. *Suggestions:*

### TRANSPARENT WATERCOLOR TUBE PAINTS:

- "artist" quality like: *Holbein, Daniel Smith, W&N, Qor, M Graham, Mameriblu . DaVinci / American Journey* make large 37 ml tubes at a fair price.
- REDS: Alizarin Crimson (or Permanent Magenta) = dark, bluish reds.  
Opera by *Holbein* is a brilliant pink = Wild Fuchsia by *American Journey*  
& Cadmium Red Lt. = hot, orangish red.
- BROWNS: Burnt Sienna = rusty, orangish/red/brown (& or Quin Burnt Orange)  
& Burnt Umber = dark yellow, chocolaty brown (varies by brand)
- YELLOWS: Cadmium Yellow Lt. (or Aureolin) = warm, orangish yellows.  
& Raw Sienna (or Yellow Ochre) = light yellow/browns, like wheat  
& or Quinacridon Gold
- BLUES: Thalo Blue = intense, greenish blue, Cobalt Turquoise/Teal  
Cobalt, Ultramarine Blue
- water soluble graphite pencil (General's *Sketch & Wash* or similar)  
& or water soluble pencil - orange color
- **Covered palette** + 2 plastic water containers, sponge(s) or towel to blot brushes on
- **Watercolor Brushes:** short handle soft hair synthetics or red sable:
  - #10 or 12 or 14 *Round*, such as Robert Simmons' *White Sable* (synthetic)
  - Flat or Angle Shader: 1" with chisel handle
  - oriental flat *HAKÉ* brush (natural hair): 1" or larger
  - Raphaël's *Soft Aqua* Quill design does similar duty to a Hake, if you prefer a round.
  - round, pointed *SCRIPT / RIGGER* #6 size or smaller
- **Paper:** plenty of 140 lb (& or 300 lb) cold press Watercolor Paper
  - *Fabriano, Saunders-Waterford* or *D'Arches* or *Kilimanjaro*,  
(1/4 or 1/2 sheet size for studio paintings, please.)
  - also needed • 11x14" tracing paper (Cheap Joe's *Starving Artist*) for sketches
- Kneaded or *Moo* eraser & pencils.
- **Support:** a slick, waterproof drawing board, such as Plexiglas or *gatorboard*
  - 1" bigger than your WC paper
- clean towel: just for blotting wet watercolor paper
  - Facial tissues and paper towels.
  - Chip clips or tape
