MUST-HAVE:

- Paintings to work on.
- Previous work (digital images or photos are fine) to share with me so I get to know your work.
- Paints (or collage) and brushes that you normally use to do your art work.
- Reference materials: of imagery if you normally paint with imagery.
Of course, total non- objective is great!
- Sketches, thoughts for themes or concepts to explore
- Prismacolor felt markers: one 50% grey, one black (for fast value studies)
- Misc.: sketchbook, pencils, scissors, spray bottle, water container...
ALL the things you normally use working in your studio.
